## How Much Does it Cost?

### Mexico

- ♦ A total deposit of \$250 is due 60 days prior to travel
- ♦ The balance of \$500 is due 30 days prior to travel



IMPORTANT: Airfare to and from Mexico City, Mexico is not included. Hotel, meals, and transportation are included.

### Egypt

- ♦ A total deposit of \$1,200 is due 60 days prior to travel
- ♦ The balance of \$800 is due 30 days prior to travel

IMPORTANT: Airfare to and from Cairo, Egypt is included. Airfare is non-refundable. However, flight insurance is available. Hotel, meals, transportation, and admission to the Great Pyramids and Sphinx are included.
